First Communion

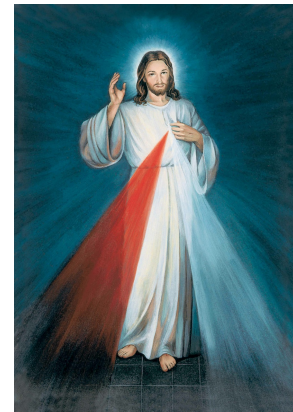
We have had a number of people from the parish generously donate First Communion dresses to our program. If you have a child that is in need of a dress, please get in touch with me.
