If you know that your student will be absent, please let me know so that we can maintain accurate attendance records.



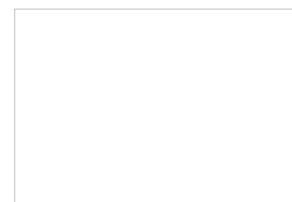
Confirmation
