Wednesday August 4th – Professor Ernest Collamati

"How to Save the Catholic Church"

The problems confronting the Church in the Third Millennium are formidable. A church in crisis aptly describes our situation. How to face and overcome the challenges that range in this country from decreased credibility of leadership to major demographic shifts, fewer priests to serve a growing Catholic population to technological advances, from closed parishes and schools to the status of women in the Church?

-- This is the final presentation in our summer series and is jointly sponsored by Saint Anthony's of East Falmouth, Christ the King of Mashpee and Our Lady of Victory of Centerville. The lecture will be held at Christ the King Parish Hall in Mashpee at 7:00pm.
